Tuesday, June 5, 1827

Four months after date, application will be made to the Inferior Court of Jones County... for leave to sell all the land and negroes belonging to the estate of **THOMAS A. Gordon**, deceased... (Signed) **JAMES Gwyn, Adm.**-(Source: GJ)

Tuesday, June 12, 1827

Now in Clinton Jail, Jones County, Georgia, a negro man who calls his name **Bob.** dark complexion, about 34 or 35 years old, who says that he belongs to **PETER Corbin**, of Columbia, South Carolina... (Signed) **JAMES Jordan, Jailor.**-(Source: GJ)

Friday, June 29, 1827

DIED: In Clinton, Jones County, on the 16th instant, **Mr. Peter Pease**, aged about 30 years.- (Source: AT)

Tuesday, July 3, 1827

CLINTON MALE ACADEMY, JONES COUNTY: Trustees: **James Smith, Horatio Bowen, William Flewellen, William B. Stephens, James Gray.**-(Source: GM)

Monday, July 9, 1827

Georgia, Jones County: **Stephen Eilands** files his petition for letters of dismissal from the estate of **Daniel Shaw**, late of said county, deceased. (Signed) **Charles Macarthy, Clerk.**-(Source: SR)

Georgia, Jones County: Will be sold before the Court House door in said county on the first Tuesday in August, next, between the legal hours of sale, all the property belonging to the estate of **William R. Sayers**, late of said county, deceased. Sold for the benefit of the heirs and creditors of said estate. (Signed) **William S. Middlebrooks, Adm.**-(Source: SR)

Georgia, Jones County: Will be sold before the Court House door in said county on the first Tuesday in October, next, between the legal hours of sale, all the property belonging to the estate of **David Morgan**, late of said county, deceased.
