

FOREWORD

This book bearing the title of INFORMATION ON SOME GEORGIA PIONEERS is based on a listing of 25,000 land lottery registrants in 1805. The family heads, widows and orphans, were then living in the 25 original Georgia counties in eastern section of the State.

Indeed they were pioneers by virtue of the eligibility rules set forth for participation in the lottery system, making available 202-1/2-acre lots in the newly created counties of Baldwin, Wilkinson and Wayne.

A book entitled 1805 GEORGIA LAND LOTTERY compiled by Virginia S. Wood and Ralph V. Wood was published in 1964. This issue gave an alphabetical listing of the participants, the counties where they lived at the time and their ticket numbers.

It was decided to examine Georgia's statistical records available and match whatever information that was found with the named registrants. The time required for this project spanned more than two years. All data found, regardless of how insignificant it may have been, was placed alongside names of registrants. The end results was this 216-page book, with an index added.

Working with statistics provides margin for errors: Common name duplications, generation gaps, etc. It will be noted the term "m. 2nd, or 2nd, w." was used often. It was done to standardize multiple marriages. In reality it may have been a third or fourth. On the other hand, it could have been that of a son, or a person bearing the same name, or one of a later generation.

There will be disclaimers and calls for proof, plus requests for sources. Since it would require re-tracing, compliance is impossible. The accountability of the 25,000 registrants is near 50 percent. The degree of accuracy outweighs what is doubtful.

The best method is using this issue is to make comparisons with the listings in 1805 GEORGIA LAND LOTTERY, which most libraries have. Cross-checking and also the use of the index in INFORMATION ON SOME GEORGIA PIONEERS is recommended for allied family connections.
