I have tried to complete the marriages that you requested previously for this report and found that when I did the first of the marriage index checking I hadn't taken time to look up all the possible family names so will report on these various searches. First of all in Sevier county marriages, Ark. book one 1007941 item one pg. 75 Marriages Charles Lyons - Debrah Compton marr. as residence of William C. Compton in Clear creek twp. 1 Sep 1844. Sevier county marr. book 2 pg. 17 Thomas Jerome Billingsley 25 Dec 1853 MaryJane Anderson, no ages stated. Marr. by Isaac W. Pearce, J. P. Pg. I1 Amanda Billingsley about 24, Sherrill French abt 22, married at house of Edward Billingsley 5 Dec 1853. pg. 245 James Hopson-Naomi Dauggett(their spelling) 9 June 1861, minister of C. P. Church married them, both of lawful age.

Sevier county, Ark. marriages, book 3, item 3, 1007041, 1866-1883 Pg. 24 Milton Blackwell- Mary E Sessions 15 Aug 1865. He of Hunt county, Texas age 26. Mary of Sevier county, age 29.

Pg. 475 Henry C. Marsh -Ada Vancill. He age 22 of Lockesburg, she age 20 of Dequeen. License 4 Aug and marr. 6 Aug 1900.

pg. 396 Marriage William McDaniel - Mattie Doggett Original marriage very faded so original not good, see photo. Marr 4 March 1900, licence day before.

I could not find the marriage of Stephen Kirk, though I looked twice.

Since Allen J. Marsh was reported in Clarke county, Ark. before coming to Sevier, I decided to check some more references there.

There was an Arkansas Bile records series compiled by the Daughters of the American revolution on films 907,977 item 6 which included records from Hempstead chapter, Pulaski chapter, Garland and Hot Springs chapters, Conway county, and Clarke county from Arkadelphia Chapter DAR pg. 82 J. E. Marsh age 30 - Julia Clark age 18 marr by M. G., J. R. Moore 22 Oct 189-. Read whole series nothing more on family names.

General Index to marriage records Clark county, Ark., film 1009942, 1819-1934. No Marsh or Wooldridge, Woolridge names or Alford names at all. Marriages Clarke county, Ark. originals on film Book C 1845-1856 Nothing, indexed.

Clark county, Ark. Deeds book A 1821-58. Worst Index I*I've ever seen for deeds. surnames not all arranged together by alphabetical listings. All mixed up, not chronological. Clarke county, Ark. will book G. 1855-67, indexed no Marsh, no Woolridge, Alford.

I looked up the Original will in Chatham county, N. Carolina on film 018,448, volume A. pgs. 59-60 for the Robert Marsh referred to as a possible father to the older Marsh living with your Elijah in 1850 census in Madison county, Tenn. in one of the Marsh books. Robert dated his will 14 March 1801 and mentions children John, William, Robert, Joseph, Henry, Alexander, Elizabeth Brantley, Barbara Griffith, Mary Hockney, Nancy Dilliard, Martha Lambert, Sarah David, Frances Taylor, Elisa Stuart and Henrietta. With your Elijah born in Georgia? I am not sure how these

families might tie in together so will continue our searching in Georgia and try to tie back to the supposed relatives in North Carolina earlier. Perhaps the Joseph of Chatham is the older Joseph reported in 1850 to have been born in North Carolina and the father of Elijah could be one of sons and could have moved to Georgia by then, or he may be a brother to this Robert and therefore, an uncle to Elijah? More checking will be done in the hopes of getting more definite proof.

It is my pleasure working with you. Hope that you two are enjoying good weather there. It is still very cold and wintry here. Until my next report I send you my best wishes.

I was surprised to find your L. L. Kirk married later in life.
