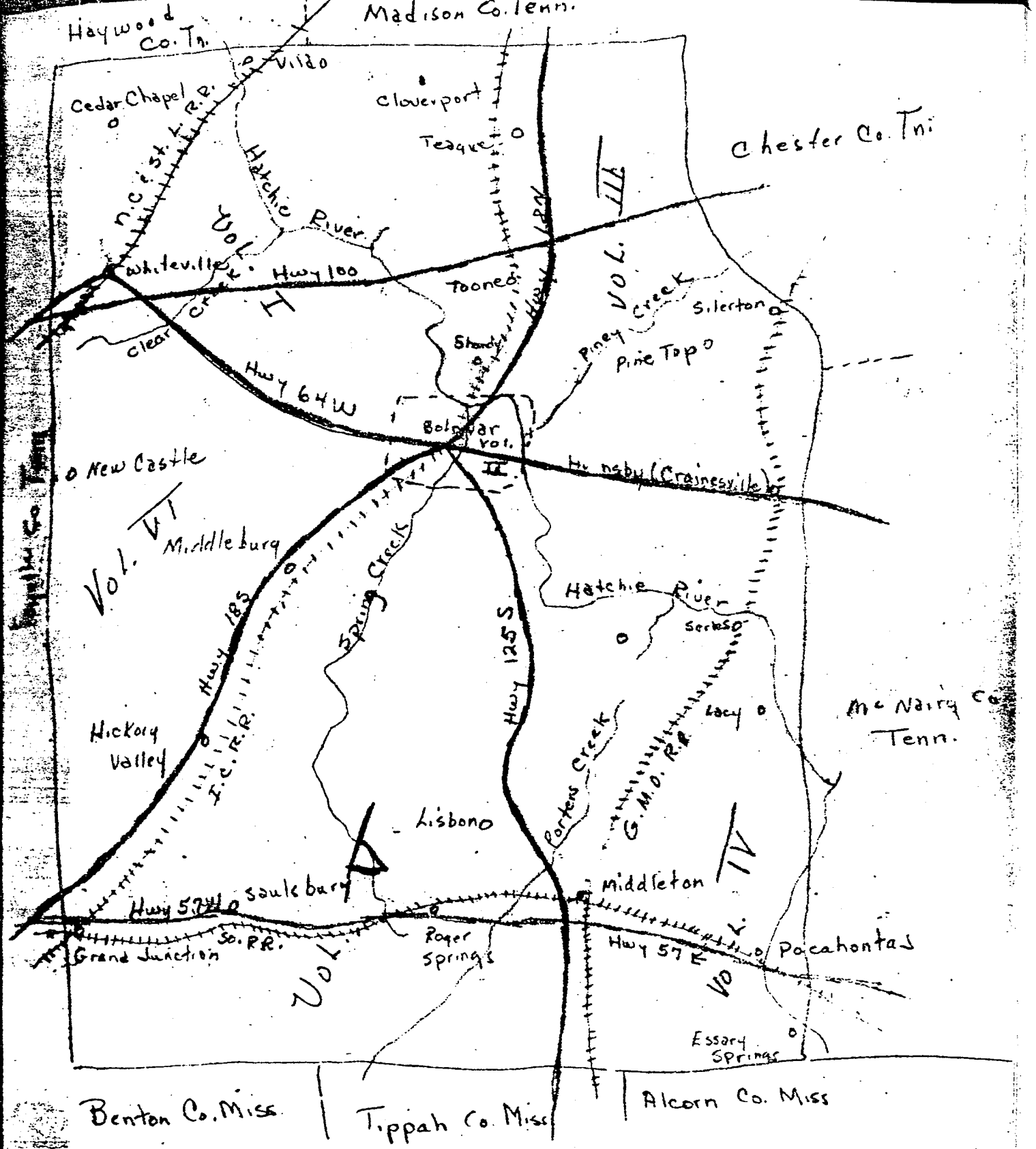

## HEBRON BAPTIST CHURCH CEMETERY

Hebron Baptist Church was organized 22 June 1894 with Rev. A. Lambert as Moderator and S.D. Jacobs as Clerk. There were 14 charter members, Rev. and Mrs. A. Lambert, Mr. and Mrs. J.F. Macon, Mr. and Mrs. S.D. Jacobs, Mr. and Mrs. C.F. Scott, R.L. Doyle, Miss Ida Doyle, Miss Josie Grantham, Miss Amanda Hensley, Miss Agnes Hayes and J.M. Tillmon.

In 1954 Hebron went to full time service with Rev. Ralph Thomas as the first full time pastor. In 1955 a complete new modern brick Building was erected. This building burned a few years later and another brick building was erected which stands today. It is S.E. of Bolivar, Take Hwy 125 S. to The Peavine or Pocahontas Road at Doyle Stores, then about 4 miles on the Peavine road.

## REHOBETH METHODIST CHURCH CEMETERY

Cemetery located south of Hebron Cemetery. The 1st. Church at Rehobeth was about 1 mile South of the present site. There are a few graves at the 1st. site but none bear markers with inscription's. The 1st. record of the Rehobeth Church we find in Deed Book L, Pg 591-2, where William R. Jacobs bequeathed unto the Methodist Episcopal Church South and the Trustees of said Church, William Jacobs, Abraham Sellars, Anson Brown, George Thompson and their successors in office a tract of land in the State of Tennessee, Hardeman County in Civil District No. 12, including the Rehobeth Meeting House containing two acres, then it gives the description, dated the 10th March 1853.

THE HISTORY OF NEW HOPE CHURCH, HARDEMAN COUNTY, TENNESSEE  
(By J. Dalton Allford - 1951)

In 1841, a gospel preacher whose name is not recalled, held a meeting in a little log school house situated in a dense forest six miles northwest of what is now Middleton, Tennessee, resulting in eight baptisms among whom were William Rose and wife, Thomas Rose, W.K. Rose, Sr., Mary Rose Britt, and Ann Sellars, the latter being the writers grandmother. He returned in 1842 for another meeting with more additions and the selection of elders and deacons. Then in 1844, Brother T.W. Haskey held a meeting enroute home from a meeting in Memphis, Tennessee.

In 1846 Brother Thomas Rose met Brother J.R. McCall at Humboldt, Tennessee and hauled him 50 or 60 miles in his ox wagon to this community for a meeting.

From 1841 we have not failed to have our annual protracted meetings. The old church has had its ups and downs but has kept alive, defending and promulgating the faith through all these years (110 years last May 1951).

The church has produced the following gospel preachers, Shepherded Spears, John Thompson, J.M. Turner, A.A. Murphey, Hughie Ray, A.A. Rose, W.K. Rose Sr., F.O. Howell, W.L. Thompson, C.M. Thompson, J.T. Stricklin, J.H. D. Thompson, and G.L. Thompson.

In the early days of the congregation its membership was composed mostly of people who had immigrated from North Carolina, largely Methodist and Hardshell Baptist, many of whom could not read nor write, but all learned to be useful and happy in the work of the Lord. Many of them could quote and locate more scripture than the average man of today. Our families wore home-woven clothes, chewed home-grown tobacco and spit the way their spitting machine was turned. The elderly women smoked stone pipes and the younger ones kept their teeth clean with soot, powdered charcoal and black gum toothbrushes. They wore long dresses and sat with both feet on the floor at all times. The writer well remembers when ladies who walked to church and most everybody did, carried their Sunday shoes and stockings in hand until they were near the meeting house. Sometimes the young men would carry them for them, and when time came to put them on they would gaze out into space with their backs turned toward the ladies while they donned their home-knit hose, string garters, and best shoes.

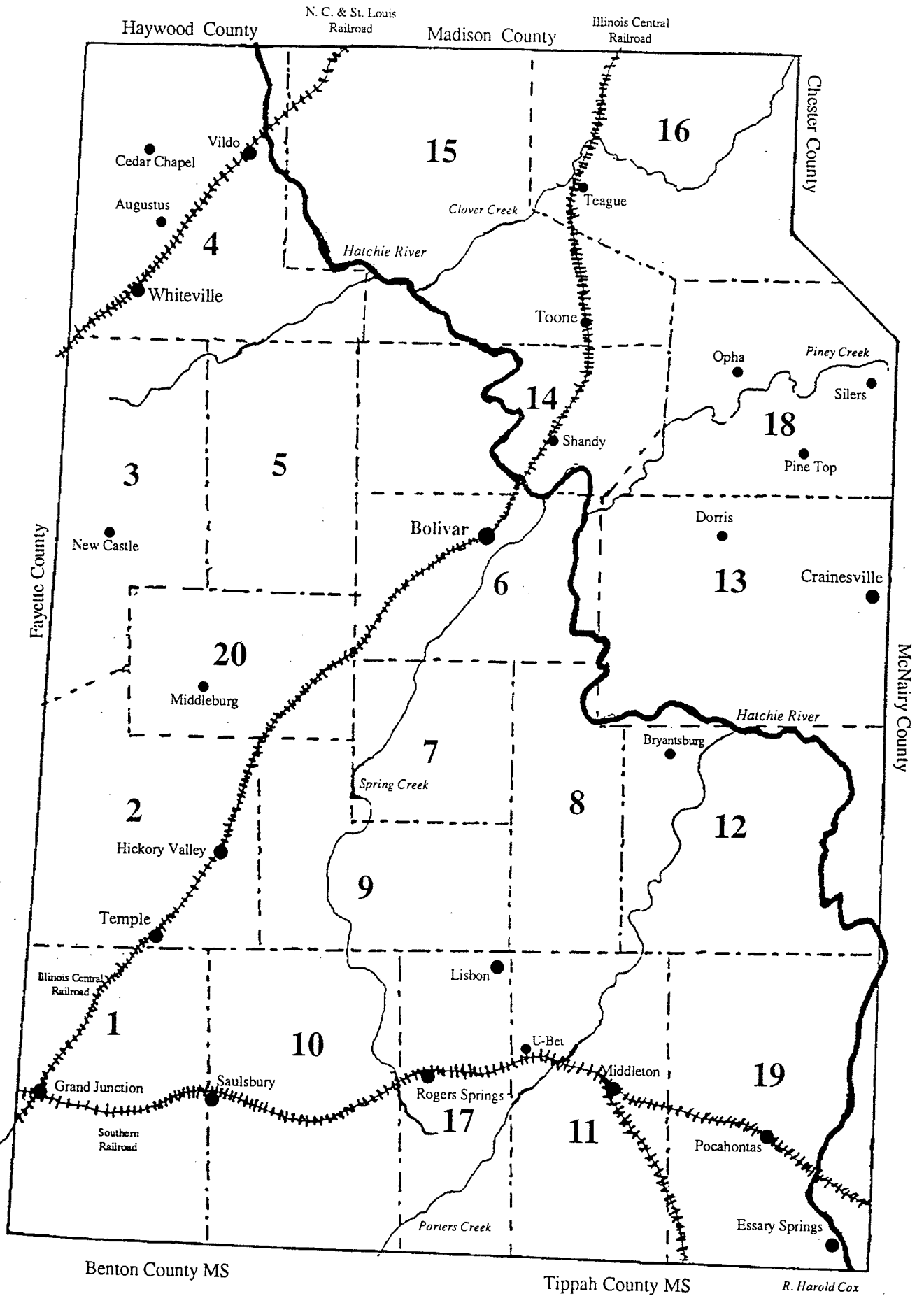

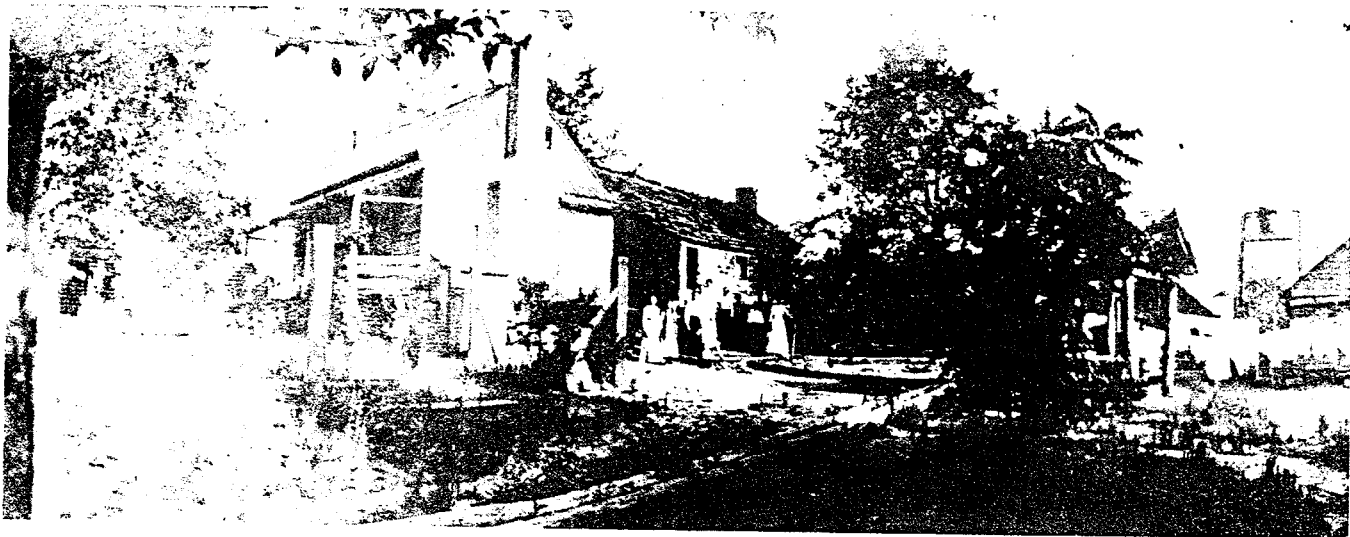
## WILLIAM AND CHELLIE BASS

(23 November 1853-26 September 1924) married Alice Cheshier 2 January 1879. (9) John (2 December 1856-29 October 1922) buried in Mackey Cemetery. He married first, M.O. ## JOSEPH AND ALCEY HOUSE

Joseph House (7 May 1780) in Edgecombe County, North Carolina, the son of John and Mary House. He was only eleven years old when his father's will was probated in the county and state of his birth, and was fifteen years old when his mother's estate was settled in 1796. In 1801 Joseph sold the property he inherited from his parents, left Edgecomb County and migrated to middle Tennessee. He married Alcey Bedwell, daughter of Reubin Bedwell, 5 January 1807 in Davidson County. Joseph engaged in farming and raising stock. He lived in Bedford, Maury and Williamson Counties before settling in Hardeman County in 1836. He and his wife were faithful members of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church. Alcey House died in 1845 in Hardeman County. Joseph left Hardeman County in 1853, moving to West Point, Arkansas, where he lived until his death 26 July 1861. He is buried on the banks of the Little Red River in the West Point Cemetery. Joseph and Alcey House were the parents of:

Reubin, (1809-1891) and Elizabeth his wife bought land in Hardeman County in 1851, and then migrated to White County, Arkansas;

Patience married David Haynes 26 October 1836 in Maury County and had two sons, Joseph and Frank;

S. John, 1811-1895, married first Teresa Twigg, second Mary Elizabeth Kelso the 28 May 1861 in Haywood County and settled there in Old District No. 1;

William, (1812) married Virginia Bedwork and was living with his wife and four children, Eliza, James, William and Christopher, in Hardeman County in 1850;

Jane, (1815) married David House of South Carolina, 22 December 1843 in Hardeman County and by 1850 had moved to Haywood County;

Charlotte, (9 January 1817) married Rev. John Myers the 6th of December 1848 in Hardeman County, died there 25 January 1880 and is buried in the Mt. Vernon Methodist Church Cemetery. Known children of John and Charlotte Myers were Mary Caroline, Joseph John and Octavia Araminter, all born in Hardeman County;

Marcenee, (1819) married James M. Brazell 8 September 1838 in Hardeman County and was still living in that county in 1880 in the home of her daughter Sarah who married William Doyle. Other known children of James and Marcenee Brazell were Mary Elizabeth, Louisa Frances and Sopha Emaline, all born in Hardeman County;

(8) Mary, died 1890.

(9) Archibald Bedwell, (1822-April 1906) married 21 November 1840 in Hardeman County Eliza Wilkes, the daughter of Thomas and Ruth Wilkes. Eliza was one of a family of thirteen children. The children of A.B. and Eliza House were all born in Hardeman County and are as follows: Thomas, Joseph Warren, Alcy, James Polk and Mary. A.B. and Eliza House were members of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church, New Hope Congregation and in April 1842 transferred to the Cedar Chapel Congregation. This family lived in Hardeman County until about 1853 when they moved to West Point, where A.B. lived until his death. He was a farmer and stockman. — *By Mary Ann House (Mrs. L.R.) Mitchell*

## RALPH AND NARCISSA HOWELL

Ralph Howell was born 1813 in Wayne County, North Carolina to Ralph Howell, Sr. and Jane Crawford. He grew up on a farm that bordered the Neuse River near Waynesboro. He married Narcissa Brint born 1815 in Wayne County, North Carolina to John Brint and Margaret Haywood. They came to Hardeman County with Margaret Haywood Brint Howell after the death of Ralph Howell (1770-1834), whom she had married after the death of John Brint. Ralph's brother, Wrigdon Howell and sister, Sarah Ann Howell Jernigan had already emigrated to the county as had Narcissa's brother, James Brisco Brint. Margaret Brint Howell was buried in the family cemetery, 1863.



Ralph was a surveyor and locator of land for those emigrating from North Carolina. He homesteaded an acreage for his family in eastern Hardeman County in the Bright Prospect community where his relatives had settled. He died 1849 and was buried in Little Hatchie Cemetery. Ralph and Narcissa Brint Howell are the parents of nine children: (1) Martha Louise Howell (27 August 1831-15 November 1862) married Wrigdon Rufus Jernigan. (2) Margaret Amanda Howell (21 September 1835-15 December 1879) married James Wesley Jernigan.\* (3) James Haywood Howell (1837) married first, Telitha Kennedy second, Martha Bissell third, Mary Thornton Russell. (4) Richard Columbus Howell (9 September 1839-23 January 1924) married Nancy Hooper. (5) William Henry Howell (7 December 1841-12 July 1926) married Amanda Melvina Hooper. (6) Ailsey Jane Howell (3 June 1844-23 November 1923) married Wrigdon Rufus Jernigan;\* second Benjamin Franklin Majors. (7) Sarah E. Howell (1846). (8) Lucinda Caroline Howell (1848). (9) Robert Franklin Howell (1849) married Serilda Hooper. Moved to Louisiana.

Narcissa Howell reared this large family of children on the farm and weathered the Civil War and its devastation. She sent three sons to war for the Confederacy. She innovated several plans to keep provisions for her family through the winters when both armies foraged the countryside. She saw order restored after Reconstruction. The family worshipped at Little Hatchie Baptist Church and the children attended the intermittent subscription schools held there.

Narcissa Brint Howell died 12 February 1897 and was buried in Little Hatchie Cemetery. — *By Faye Tennyson Davidson*

## JAMES HAYWOOD HOWELL

James Haywood Howell was born in Hardeman County 17 May 1837, son of Narcissa Brint and Ralph Howell.\*

Haywood stated in a questionnaire filed with the Tennessee State Archives in 1922 that he grew up in a 3 room log cabin on a 200 acre farm. He worked on the farm and attended the Hatchie School House about a half mile from his home. It was a subscription school that lasted two to four months a year.

Haywood married Seletha J. Brown about 1856 or 7. He and Seletha had four children, William Thomas, James Franklin, Elizabeth "Betty", and John Raiford.

He enlisted in the Confederate Army 17 May 1861, serving in the 9th Infantry, Company F, "the Middleton Tigers." He was in the Battle of Shiloh with Maney's 1st Tennessee and in the battles at Perryville, Murfreesboro, Chickamauga, Missionary Ridge, Kennesaw Mountain and Franklin, Tennessee. He was wounded in one of these battles and spent two weeks in a hospital. He was discharged in 1865 and made the trip home by train. He lived with his mother following the war.

Seletha died in the early 1870's and Haywood married Martha C. Bizzell in McNairy County 24 December 1873. They

had two children, Ophelia (1875) and Sarah (1877). Martha died 1 Feb. 1878 and is buried in Hatchie Cemetery.

Haywood married Seletha Elizabeth Kennedy in Hardeman County 23 March 1879. They had one child, Lee. He married Mary Thornton Russell in McNairy County 15 Nov. 1883. She was a widow with several children. They lived in western McNairy County. Haywood farmed and worked as a veterinarian. He was a small man with a white beard and he rode a small horse or pony on his trips. He was a great storyteller and all the children in the community enjoyed it when his veterinarian duties required him to spend the night. Haywood died sometime after 1922 and is buried in a unmarked grave at Eureka Cemetery in McNairy County.

Haywood's oldest son William Thomas married "Molly" Kennedy and had one son, James Frank, born in 1879. He married second, Powell Russell 26 November 1884 and they had 4 children, Benjamin, Mada, William Raiford, and Minnie Bell. He married third, Minnie King 18 March 1892 and they had five children, Lessie, Jessie, Essie, Howard and Buford. William T. died 20 October 1912 and his wife Minnie died 10 February 1946. They are buried in Mt. Pleasant Cemetery in western McNairy County.

James Franklin married and moved to Louisiana. Elizabeth married Bill Johnson and they had eight children, Hattie, Turner, Albert, Tom, Prentiss, Andrew, Minnie, and Lizzie. Elizabeth "Betty" died about 1907 and is buried in an unmarked grave at Mt. Pleasant. John Raiford Howell married Nancy Styles in 1888 and moved to Mississippi. They had two children, Earl and Pearl. Rafe died in his sleep while on a visit to his father, Haywood, and is buried in an unmarked grave at Mosses Creek Cemetery in McNairy County. — *By Virginia Pierce Howell*

## WILLIAM AND MELVINA HOWELL

William Henry Howell, son of Ralph Howell\* of Wayne County, North Carolina and Narcissa Brint was born 7 December 1841 near Crainville. William Henry was a Confederate soldier in the "Middleton Tigers Company." He married December 1861 Amanda Melvina Hooper, born 10 September 1846 to Jeremiah Hooper and Eleanor Gilmore, at the bride's home by Squire Mitchell.

William Henry was a farmer. He homesteaded the land where he lived and reared his family in the Piney Grove Community. They worshipped in the Piney Grove Baptist Church. He died 12 July 1925; Melvina died 12 February 1926. They are buried in Piney Grove Cemetery. They were parents of twelve children:

Ralph Franklin Howell was born 13 March 1871 in Piney Grove, son of William Henry (1841-1925) and Amanda Melvina Hooper Howell (1846-1926). He married in 1890 Esta Lee Wilson born 1874 in McNairy County, Tennessee, died 11 February 1916. They lived in the Piney Grove and attended Piney Grove Baptist Church. He was a farmer and avid horse trader. He loved horses and was skilled in training them, and always owned a beautiful saddle horse. Beulon Howell (1911), died at age ten.

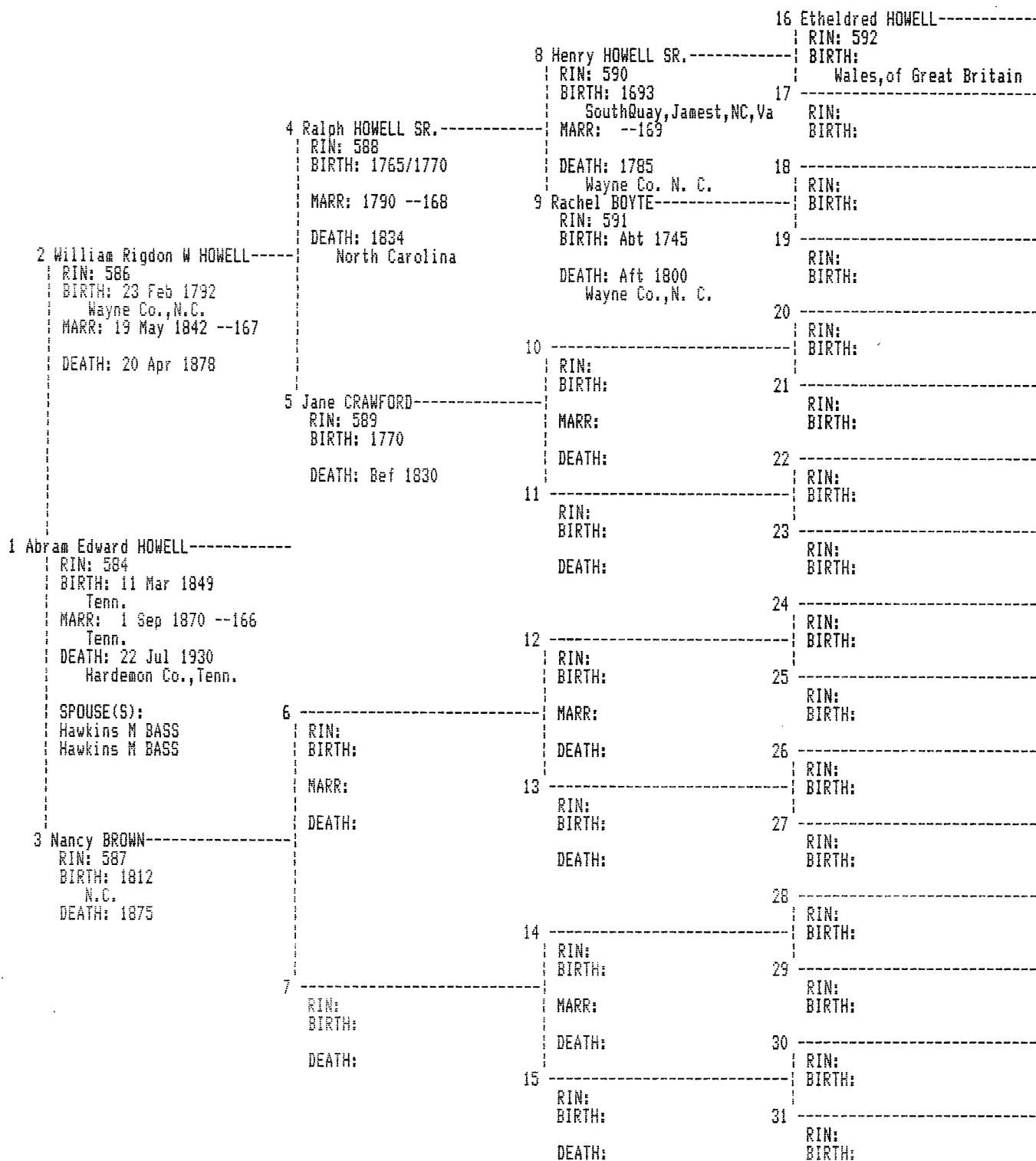

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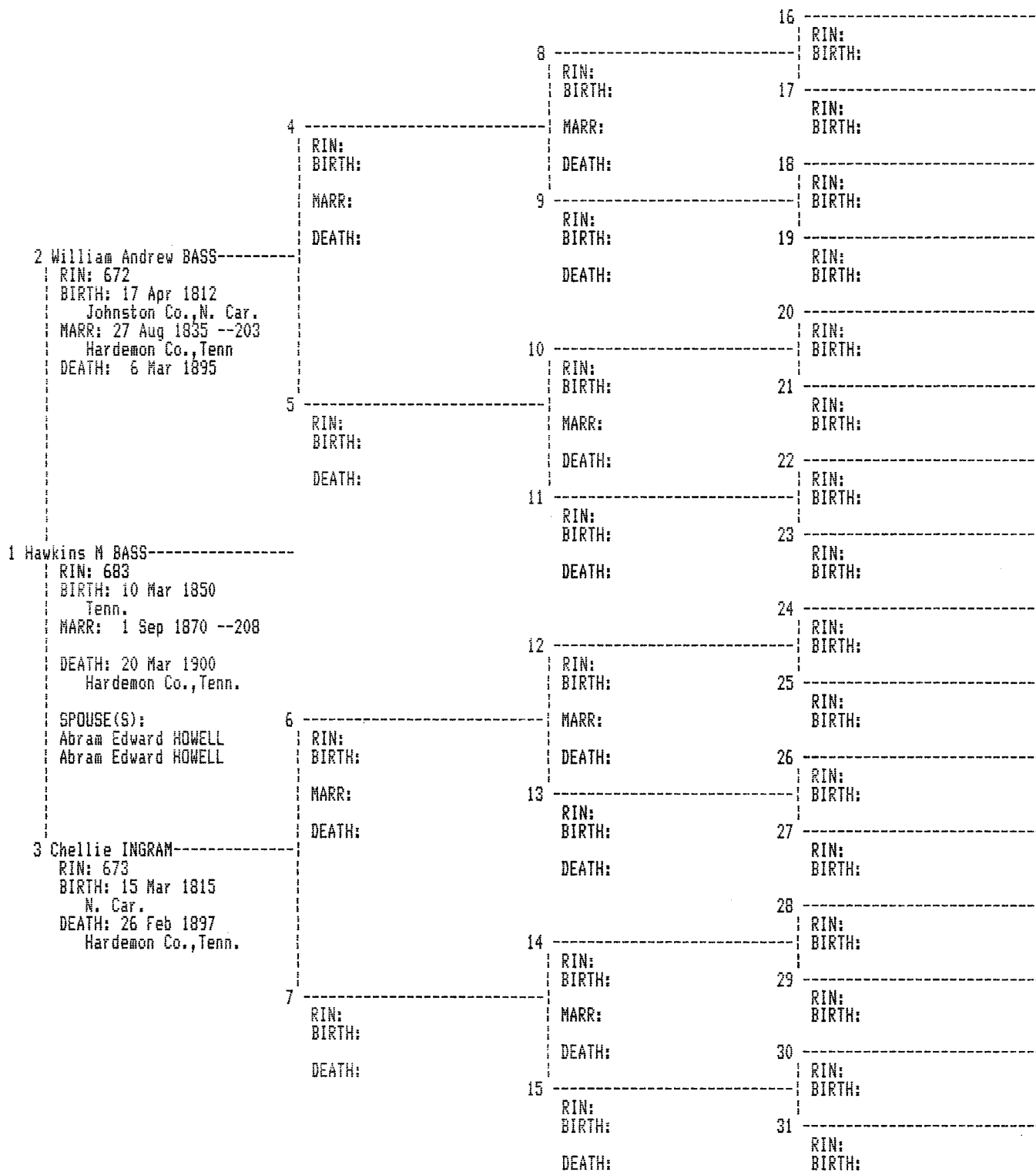
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
