

THE SETTLERS

When George Walton, signer of the Declaration of Independence, came again in 1785 to hold court in Wilkes he was struck with the increase in immigration since peace, as he had been previously with the "astonishing rapidity of settlement." He uses even stronger language than ever before. He speaks of "this county in which there is such a prodigious influx of inhabitants," and "of the rage which has taken place in the northern and neighboring states of removing into this."

The old records in the office of Ordinary give us the names of grand jurors, petty jurors, and in many cases of witnesses. These bear out George Walton's words and show also the very fine class of immigrants which the county was receiving. Among the persons whose names we find prior to 1788 are George Lumpkin, John Rutherford, John Hill, Thos. Ansley, Nathanael Howell, Thomas Wootten, Burwell Pope, John Lindsey, Frederic Sims, William Pollard, Wm. Of course the names that get into records show but a small part of those who came. But this list, to the older people who have known this and the neighboring counties, tells us much of the number and character of early immigration. I will a little further on say a few words in elucidation of it to others. The rapid influx makes us understand why, about the first business that came before the courts when they were held in 1782 was the licensing of Thomas Carter's Ferry. Ferries were especially needed, for the ancestors of more than half of our present Georgia, Alabama and Mississippi were coming across the Savannah river on the roads leading from the northeast through old Wilkes county. The people living in Carolina and Georgia at the junction of Broad River with Savannah, got such grand ideas in their heads that the names of Carolina town, Vienna the Elbert county town in the fork St. Petersburg; the Lincoln county town, Lisbon. These were magnificent names, and when one crosses the river at the point now, there are a few old houses,




