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business with E. P. McNeal. Evalina McNeal married General George Peters and died before the Civil War. While the General was at war her two youngest children, Clara and George Peters, lived with E. P. McNeal and his wife, Ann.

Albert Thomas McNeal married Mary Jane Dunlap and moved to Coffeerville, Mississippi where he joined an established law firm. After about three years, while Mary Jane was expecting their second child, Albert died. His older brother, Ezekiel McNeal, who had married Ann Williams and had one daughter, Priscilla, brought Mary Jane back to Bolivar. He looked after them until she married Austin Miller. They had four children. Their son, Charles Miller, lived in "Magnolia Manor", the house that his father built.

Albert's children, Albert and Irene, lived with both families, getting most of their discipline from Uncle McNeal and Aunt Ann. Albert was a slight, blonde boy when he joined the company recruited around Bolivar. He was eighteen when The Battle of Shiloh was fought. All of the family spent the day on the west porch of "McNeal Place", praying and listening to the guns. When the firing ceased they joined the townspeople at the depot. Albert did come back, but every officer in his company was either killed or wounded. He gathered the company together during the retreat and they made him Captain for the remainder of the war. Albert inherited "McNeal Place" and lived there with his wife, Sally Fentress, and their eight children until 1900 when he took his family to Sewanee where he was Dean of Law at the University of the South.

Irene McNeal married Lewis Bond of Brownsville and had four children: one McNeal Bond married Cornelia Foard of Nashville, both died young leaving a four year old daughter, Kate, who married R.G. Morrow of Memphis and had three children, R.G. Jr., Lewis Bond, and Irene McNeal, who married Richard Leatherman. Lewis Bond died in the 1878 yellow fever epidemic. Irene brought her children back to Bolivar to live with her Uncle McNeal. Later Irene married Jerome Hill. When Albert sold the house in 1900, Jerome Hill bought it for his wife. They came back to Bolivar to live bringing her four year old granddaughter. Jerome Hill died in 1905 and Irene in 1922. Irene, her daughter, who married Thomas R. Smith Jr., lived in "McNeal Place" with her husband and two children, Kate and Thomas. After her death in 1959 the house was vacant for twenty years. Now, Irene Bond McDonnell, the widow of James Walter McDonnell, is living there. — *By Mrs. Walter McDonnell*

DANIEL AND ANNIE McQUEEN

Daniel N. McQueen, son of William and Martha Hogan McQueen was born in Grand Junction, 13 September 1871. He lived in Hardeman County many years before and after his marriage April 20, 1893 to G. Annie Alberson. Annie was born 18 November 1879 in Mississippi.

Daniel and Annie were the parents of twelve children: Willie, (18 January 1894-1896); Myrtle Ellen (1896-1953) married James Robert (Jim) Snow; Mary E. (1899-1919); Lonnie Butler (1903-1963) married Nan Earnest; Nable Bell (1905) married Louis Franklin Snow; Clara (1907), married William Kee; Clifton (1909), married Mattie Lea Bowles; Daniel (Dan) (1911-1968) married Pauline Vaughn; Velma (1913), married Houston Kee; Dewitt (1915) and twins, Louise and Lucille, 11 September 1917. Louise married Grover Gossett, Lucille married Ralph Parker. Daniel and Annie reared Jim McQueen from an infant, who was not her child by birth. He died 1 August 1947.

Daniel was a farmer during the years the family lived in Hardeman County. They had domestic help, whom the children lovingly called "Aunt Mandy". She often accompanied the family to Van Buren Baptist Church to help with the babies and younger children.

They moved to Collierville, Tennessee about 1929, where he was manager for Cox's dairy. Daniel died June 15, 1967. Annie died Oct. 25, 1967. They were buried in Magnolia Cemetery in Collierville. — *By Evelyn (Snow) Hatcher*

WILLIAM MACON

William Macon was born 20 November 1786 in Randolph County, North Carolina, the son of John Macon and his second wife, Elizabeth Bowdon Macon. William married Martha Randolph Jennings (11 September 1782-17 January 1859). Randolph-Macon College in Virginia was named for these two families. William and Martha Randolph Macon migrated to Hardeman County in 1833. The Macon family settled on Cub Creek, southeast of Bolivar, and erected a house of logs, part of which stands in 1979.

William and Martha Macon were parents of eight children (1) Isaiah, born 13 December 1819, North Carolina, married Eldis Cox, 17 March 1842, Hardeman County; (2) David, born 4 April 1821, North Carolina, married Ailsa Elizabeth Jacobs, 21 November 1848, Hardeman County; (3) Louisa Macon, born North Carolina, married James Sain 19 December 1843, Hardeman County; (4) Bailey Macon, born 23 September 1823, married Martha Ann Fortune*, Bolivar; (5) Whitson Macon*, born 3 April 1825, Montgomery County, North Carolina, married Jane Maria Jourdan, 7 February 1849, Hardeman County; (6) Wincy Sarah Macon born 1828, North Carolina, married James I. Jordan, 30 January 1848; (7) Elizabeth Macon, born 1830, North Carolina, married Johnathan Cox; (8) Jane Macon, born 1833; (9) Tennessee married Ingrid Graham, 17 August 1851.

William farmed and raised livestock until his death 31 March 1857. They are buried in the Jordan family cemetery near Hebron. — *By Helen Freeland; Mary Carter Brown*

freesboro. Mahlon received his education at Washington Lee University. He was a Ford dealer for many years; a charter member of Rotary Club; active in the Methodist Church; served as Mayor of Bolivar; and liked sports, especially golf.

Mary received her education at Tennessee College, Murfreesboro. They had four daughters: Elizabeth Neese; Glenn Allen; Mary Linda; and Martha Lilly, twins. All four were graduates of the University of Tennessee in Knoxville.

Elizabeth Neese married Dotson Hill Felton of South Boston, Virginia. They have three children: Mary Berkeley; Elizabeth Jeffres; and Dotson Hill, Jr.

Glenn Allen married Archibald Owen II of Lewisburg, Pennsylvania. They have three sons, Archibald III, Carter and Henry.

Mary Linda married Philip Schneider of Chicago, Illinois. They have six children, Martha Glenn, Mary Beth, John Mahlon, Linda, David and Patrick.

Harris. They were the parents of Albert; Cora; Arthur; Mattie; Montie; John; Elliott; Worda; Walter; and Clatye. (3) William P. (Billy) (March 1857-8 July 1935) married Tennie Brooks 29 December 1907. They were the parents of two children. (4) Mathis (1859-1870). (5) Julia E. (20 February 1862-9 January 1942) married George W. Breeden. (6) Mary (Mollie) born 1864, died young. (7) Ida B. (10 June 1865-27 November 1908) married J. Lee McCracken. (8) David W. wish for his services. He enjoyed restoring old homes. It was his privilege to restore "Woodlawn" his great uncle's (Major Charles Michie) home in LaGrange, which is now in the National Register. He was a member of Grand Junction Baptist Church, a deacon and a Mason.

This William either died and no probate matters in court in Virginia, or he moved on into the Carolinas or further west.
